Street Legal

The SCROOSER is in the EU for driving on the roads authorized. An insurance license plate ("moped") is required.

Helmet Requirements

For the 25 km/h version, wearing a helmet is mandatory in the EU. For the 20 km/h version it is not required in Germany. For safety, we suggest always wearing a helmet while riding.

But regulations might differ across countries, so please check local regulations for clarification.
